Policy, planning, design and construction of Sustainable Habitats requires huge resources, sensitization, awareness, apart from capacity building of all stakeholders. This course will teach Planning and Design approaches of adequate housing, modern & energy saving construction technologies for pre fabrication, innovative building technologies and materials.

- Analyse various challenges and prospects of affordable and Inclusive cities in their country;
- Understand the importance of urban and spatial planning, redevelopment and rejuvenation of settlements;
- Understand prospects and challenges of planning and designing of affordable housing and prepare DPRs;
- Learn strategies to mitigate climate change and disasters and reduce vulnerability through innovative and standards based Designing tools;
- Understand Strategies for Governance & Housing finance;
- Planning for Renewable energy use, preservation of Urban Biodiversity and environmental management for Housing sector in Brunei Darussalam;
