International Programme on Development of Education Policy for Educational Administrators from Cambodia

The Institute

The National Institute of Educational Planning and Administration (NIEPA) is a premier organization engaged with capacity building and research in policy making, planning and administration of education. The Institute was established by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India. The Institute is an apex national institution of educational planning and administration and is actively engaged in educational research, training and consultancy.

The Programme

At the request of the Government of Cambodia an on-line programme has been designed for e-ITEC keeping in view the role of the education officers serving in the Ministry of Education of Cambodia. The programme delves into the development of a public educational policy framework which is a very challenging task. In this context this programme will enable the participating officers to understand the nuances of laying the basic foundations and agenda for the development of a public policy which in turn will enable them to implement the policy successfully in order to attain the educational goals of the country. In this regard the participating officers will be introspecting the existing policy of the country and understand the evidences gained from the researches and educational and economic data available as well as the socio-economic and cultural factors which reflect the needs of the citizens of the country. The participating officers will share their experiences of the current policy of the country and articulating the advantages gained out of it and what more can be achieved etc.

Objectives of the Programme

- The participating education officers will be acquainted to the concept of developing agenda for policy formulation and its importance;
- They will also be provided with the inputs on the ways and means by which they can develop and implement the public educational policy; and
- The participating officers will be provided an opportunity to construct the agenda for developing a model policy and its implementation as well as the importance of developing a continuous method of monitoring and evaluation of policy.





Target Group

This course is for middle-level education officials with good working knowledge in English. Nominees should either be working or be expected to work in the capacity of Head of the Institution.

- Heads of educational institutions, regional and district education departments, teachertraining colleges who are likely to assume higher responsibilities in educational planning and administration.
- Officials from middle-level management engaged in the planning and administration of elementary and secondary sectors of education at the national, provincial, district or institutional level and also at the system level (i.e., Ministry of Education or Directorates of Education).

Eligibility

- Graduates/Post graduates in any disciple with minimum five years of working experience in a government sector.
- Working knowledge (both spoken and written) of English language.
- Participants should possess basic computer literacy, and should be well-versed with the use of Power Point and Word Processing. More particularly experience to handle online meetings on their own.

Programme Design

The programme has been designed for two weeks with fifteen hours of live online sessions with NIEPA Faculty in addition 3-4 hours of study each day for academic interaction. Participants will join the programme through the web-links generated by NIEPA. Online training will be imparted through the Learning Management System (LMS) used by the institute for assignments and group activities.

During live sessions, participants are expected to have laptops/smart phones with good internet connectivity and the ability to log into Google Meet. Participants should have a Gmail account.

Digital attendance will be taken for each session, based on which the participation certificates will be issued.
